



Job Vacancy: GP Seaman (6-month contract)

We are currently looking to hire skilled Greek & English speaking GP Seamen on a temporary basis for a period of six months to crew as GP Seaman on Tug boats, Pilot boats or our shore operations.

The job holder will be required to crew any vessel, including maintenance of the vessels, and act as a member of the mooring team, providing mooring services for the vessels calling the port. He/she must be fully conversant with ship mooring, equipment and associated rope work. He/she will also be required to follow health, safety, security and quality procedures of P&O Maritime in his/her work procedure.

Key responsibilities will include, but not limited to:

- To act as General Purpose Seaman in the mooring team by providing assistance as required for arriving and departing vessels.
- To proficiently handle tow lines to and from any vessel to ensure its safe movement.
- To effectively use VHF Radio Equipment to receive and pass information.
- To act as directed by the Mooring Foreman and/or Tug Master, when assigned on-board, following instructions before, during and after any vessel movement.
- To follow the applicable roster ensuring his/her attendance punctuality at all the times.
- To perform any general purpose duties ashore or on-board, such as cleaning and painting.
- To promptly perform any other duties requested by his/her Line Manager.

To be considered for this position, the candidate must possess the following qualifications:

- STCW Able Seaman is preferred.
- Basic Safety Training Certificate.
- Previous experience in a similar working environment.
- Good knowledge and understanding of English language both written and oral, an advantage.
